Below is an overview of what we will be learning this term.

Science	In Science, we will be learning about major organs in our body including the heart and circulation system and how to keep our bodies healthy.
Geography	In Geography we will be learning about Great Britain and our coastal areas. We will be locating key areas on the UK Map and will be looking at both human and physical features of Coastal towns.
Art	In Art we will be learning all about 'Andy Warhol' and we will be creating our own pop art inspired masterpiece using key painting skills.
ICT	In ICT, as well as continuing our focus on e-safety, the children will be learning about managing information online and about key skills to stay safe online.
RE	In RE we will be exploring religions that are strong in our area and comparing them to the other religions we have learned about this year.
PE	In PE, We will be learning key skills in rounders and athletics. We will be showing some of these skills during Sports Day!
PSHE	In PSHE we will be exploring our bodies at the changes that occur during puberty. We will also be looking at the world of drugs and alcohol.
Music	This term we will be continuing to use Charanga. We will be learning the popular song 'Make You Feel My Love' by Adele and using this as a basis to explore musical elements including pitch and rhythm.
Spanish	We will be continuing to develop our Spanish language skills and vocabulary.
